

General Summer Camp Rules

For Parents and Guardians:

- Full payment must be paid before your child arrives at the campsite.
- No money refunds will be granted for any camper who withdraws from camp at any time upon arrival. There is no reduction or refund of fees for late arrival or early departure.
- Visitation days are every Sunday.
- Parents cannot stay on camp premises for more than 30 minutes during pick-up, drop-off and/or visitation times.
- Parents are not allowed to pack/unpack camper's luggage. We advise the campers to take part in the initial packing process at home. This helps build independence.
- Please do not pack anything edible (food, snacks, gum, drinks, etc.)
- No smoking or littering permitted anywhere on the campsite.

For Campers:

- Respect the property of the camp. Treat everything in a way that protects and preserves all property.
- Do not litter.
- Honor all equipment that is checkouted and in use.
- Clean up after yourself.
- Respect camper's and staff's property.
- Respect others in the same way you wish to be respected.
- All campers should participate in and follow the planned program. Each individual is
 expected to follow the daily routine of camp life, including hours of rising, mealtimes,
 and bedtime hours. Campers are expected to follow the schedule and be on time.
- Camp is a time to meet new friends. We ask that all campers mix and mingle with everyone else. We do not guarantee that friends will participate in all activities together. Groups of friends that exclude other campers will be separated.

- All campers are expected to conduct themselves in a safe manner. Contact an adult staff member immediately if you don't feel well or if someone gets hurt.
- Campers may not leave the facility unless accompanied by a parent, guardian or staff member.
- Shoes must be worn at all times, both indoors (slippers) and out, except when swimming in the pool.
- Food is not allowed in the rooms at any time; it attracts bugs and animals.
- Campers are permitted to bring their phones but on the condition that it will be kept in the camp's office storage. Campers may use their phones only during scheduled times.
- Parent phone calls are Sunday 11:00 AM to 2:00 PM.
- Do not bring hazardous materials or equipment.
- Drugs, alcohol or use of tobacco and/or vape products are prohibited.
- You are responsible for safeguarding any valuables that you bring with you.
- The camp should be quiet by 10:45 PM and remain quiet until 8:00 AM.

I understand that if I break any of the camp's rules, the Camp Rockledge staff will take disciplinary action, which may include being asked to correct a behavior, exclusion from activities, a phone call home, and/or permanent withdrawal from the camp.
